Materials

20 gauge Soft Flex® Art Wire™ Silver-Plated Peridot - 9 inches

20 gauge Soft Flex® Art Wire™ Silver-Plated Orange - 9 inches

20 gauge Soft Flex® Art Wire™ Silver-Plated Fuchsia - 17 inches

Clear Assorted David Christensen Hand Blown
Furnace Glass Beads - 10 beads

Tools

Flush Cutters

Chain Nose Pliers

Round Nose Pliers

Flat Nose Pliers

Instructions

Step 1: Sort through the glass beads to find 1 bead only about 5mm in height. Use 2" of fuchsia wire to form a wire wrapped loop that attaches to the 5mm bead. Use the other end of the wire to form a wire wrapped loop, with the wire coils overlapping the coils of the previous wire wrapped loop.

Step 2: Use 3" of peridot wire to form a wire wrapped loop that attaches to the previous wire wrapped loop. String 1 bead and form a wire wrapped loop.

Step 3: Use 3" of orange wire to form a wire wrapped loop that attaches to the previous wire wrapped loop. String 1 bead and form a wire wrapped loop.

Step 4: Use 3" of fuchsia wire to form a wire wrapped loop that attaches to the previous wire wrapped loop. String 1 bead and form a wire wrapped loop.

Step 5: Repeat Step 2. Repeat Step 4. Repeat Step 3. Repeat Step 4. Repeat Steps 2 and 3.

Step 6: Use flat nose pliers to hold 6" of fuchsia wire 2" from one end of the wire. Bend the wire 180°. Use the long end of the wire to form a wire wrapped loop that attaches to the final orange wire wrapped loop formed in Step 5, making sure the wire coils cover the other end of the wire. Place round nose pliers 1/2" from the folded end and bend the wire back 180° to form a hook, making sure the hook is large enough to fit through the 5mm bead used in Step 1.
